

AFTER A COUPLE OF YEARS, THE SQUIRRELS AND THE CROWS MADE A COUPLE OF MODS NECESSARY

After the squirrels opened up their food access opening, the crows learned to land on the feeder and grab some food.



I found that installing a couple of long screws prevented the crows from accessing the food, but the squirrels could still get the food from below.

To make food access easier, the squirrels chewed a half-moon opening in the food cup. I smoothed the edge to make it easier for the squirrels.

NEW CROW/RAVEN RESISTANT FEEDER DESIGN, BASED ON REAL-LIFE SQUIRREL AND CROW ACTIVITIES



Using a large angle bracket, the feeder can be mounted a couple of inches out from the tree. This allows the half-moon cutout for squirrel food access to face the tree. This may prevent crows from accessing the food without the need for long screw food protectors.
